


Jerusalem at the Time of Jesus — 1st Century A.D.

#1 _____

The place outside the city gate where Jesus was crucified. It means “the place of the skull.”


Matthew 27:33–37



#2 _____

The hand-hewn cave that Joseph of Arimathea donated for Jesus’ burial and the surrounding area where Christ appeared to Mary Magdalene the morning of his resurrection.

John 19:38–20:17



#3 _____

The Roman headquarters where Jesus was sentenced to death by Pilate and then abused by his Roman soldiers.

John 18:28–19:16



#5 _____

Jerusalem’s holy place where Jesus visited as a boy — and worshiped and taught as a man.

This was the 2nd one built in Jerusalem. It was destroyed by Rome in 70 A.D.

The Dome of the Rock (a Muslim shrine) now stands in its place. The rock is thought to be the foundation stone upon which the Ark of the Covenant sat in the Holy of Holies. It is also considered to be the place where Abraham set up the altar to sacrifice his son Isaac.



#6 _____

A section of the Temple where the Jews tried to stone Jesus for saying that he and the Father are one.

#10 _____

The grove of olive trees where Jesus prayed the night before he was betrayed and arrested.

Matthew 26:36–46 and Luke 22:39–54



#11 _____

The mountain top from which Jesus ascended into heaven 40 days after his resurrection.

Acts 1:9–12



#15 _____

The place where Jesus was first questioned after his arrest by the High Priest and Peter denied that he knew Jesus.


Matthew 26:57–75

The house where Jesus ate the Passover meal with his disciples and established the Lord's Supper.

#17 _____

The place where Jesus was taken to be questioned by Herod Antipas, son of King Herod the Great who had magnificently remodeled the 2nd Temple.
